For a bonus point, can you come up with your own exciting words to describe the character's personality?

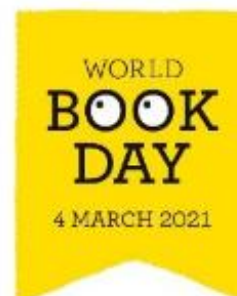
